# Principal's Thoughts

Last week the San Francisco Chronicle reported on a lawsuit that has been filed by numerous State Attorney Generals alleging that TikTok is "designed to be addictive to children and causes them harm." Here is a link to the article: States Sue TikTok. This social media platform uses recommendation algorithms that takes a user's previous viewing choices and creates suggestions based on these personal preferences. The concern presented in this lawsuit is that this algorithm gives people an unending stream of short videos that can cause dopamine levels to rise which can lead to addiction. Dopamine is one of four "feel good" hormones and is produced in the neurons of the brain. A rise in dopamine levels often creates a pleasurable response and causes the body to want more. Athletes often describe experiencing this "high" when engaging in exercise or thrill seekers when riding a roller coaster, it often leaves them wanting more. If this allegation from the Attorney Generals is true, I find this is especially concerning since I am hearing students as young as 4th grade talking about something they have seen on this app or when junior high students and high school graduates engage in pranks seen on this site. I don't envy your job as parents particularly raising children in this world of technology and social media. Fortunately PACE will be sponsoring a parent education night on this very topic.
