Planning for the upcoming school year is designated by the school department to take place during the months of January-March. Currently, the School Board, Mrs. Kelley and I are focused specifically on enrollment and formulating the preliminary budget. New student applications have been coming in at a fast pace and this Saturday we will hold our new student testing sessions. In order to know how many openings we have in each class we will need to know your plans. Of course we like to assume you are returning, however we need your official word. Last week, the Intent to Return form was sent home in your family envelope and we ask that you return this by Friday. The most important factor when planning our upcoming budget is knowing how many students will be attending St. Agnes in the 2025-2026 school year. On Wednesday, February 12th your FACTS account will be charged \$250 for the 1st installment of your registration fee, unless we hear specifically that your family is not returning. Please remember, this is a non-refundable deposit to hold your child's spot for next year. Our target enrollment for each class is 32 students so we still have some available desks to fill. Please continue to spread the word.
